Best advice for children with separation anxiety	Setting up a routine goodbye helps the child get comfortable	It's important to feel comfortable right off the bat. We emphasize an open-door policy. Come whenever you want.	Establish a relationship with the nanny before you leave, and make a shorter goodbye time.	Gradually ease the kids into a routine of not having the parents there.	We encourage the parents to stay in the classrooms on some day, so the child can build trust in their teachers
What are the education requirements of your staff?	Montessori-certified	Teachers must have early childhood development degree or like-study	High school diploma, needs to be pursuing a career in childcare and have 3–5 years experience	Background checks, most staff are CNA certified	Bachelor's or master's degree in early childhood development
What is one thing a parent should look for when choosing child-care?	A clean environment. A well-cared for environment equals well-cared for kids.	Children should feel comfortable and safe. Also look for low turnover and low teacher-to-child ratios.	Experience and references. We usually call three personal and professional references, none of which can be family.	Trust in company and workers. If you don't feel right about a certain provider, just don't do it.	Proper licensing. Also getting the feel for the environment by walking into a classroom.
What makes your service unique?	Teaching staff is dedicated. They're here because this is their passion.	We've been here since 1917, and emphasize relationship with family.	We have an 89 percent success rate for long- term nannies	We fulfill medical needs if necessary.	Teachers do home visits to get that one- on-one time in with the child
Anything you specialize in?	Catering to the child and their individual needs.	Focus is on the child's social and emotional well-being	Provide families with a live-in or live-out nanny	We're your back-up plan. We can have a worker at your door within 24 hours.
